On this issue, the jury is essentially unanimous: intensive play of high-action games has been shown to have negative cognitive effects ... Games with anti-social or violent content "have been shown to reduce empathy, to reduce stress associated with observing or initiating anti-social actions, and to increase confrontational and disruptive behaviors in the real world."
